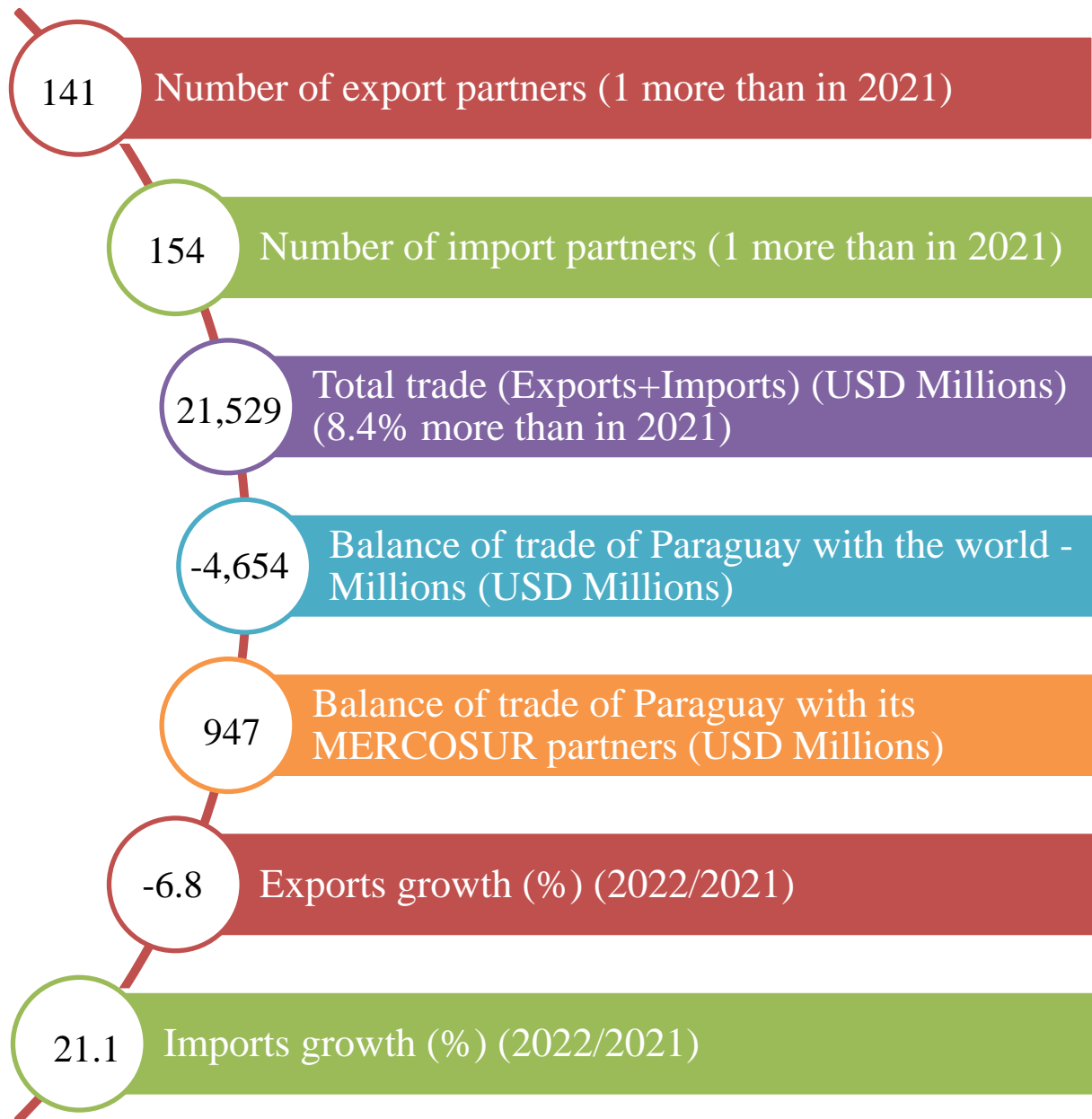

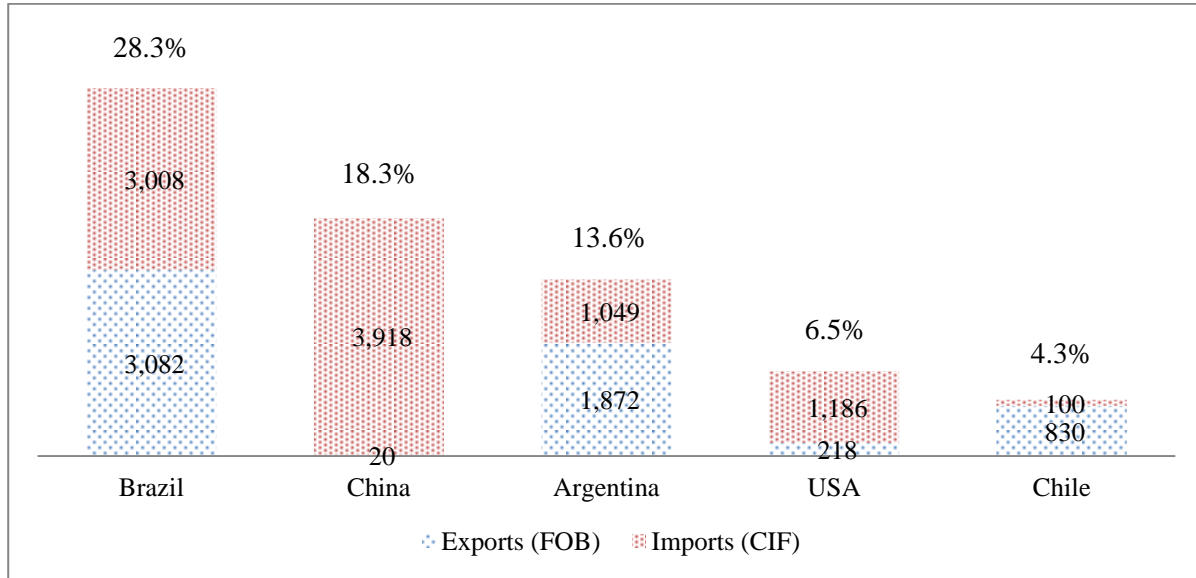

Share in total trade (percent)

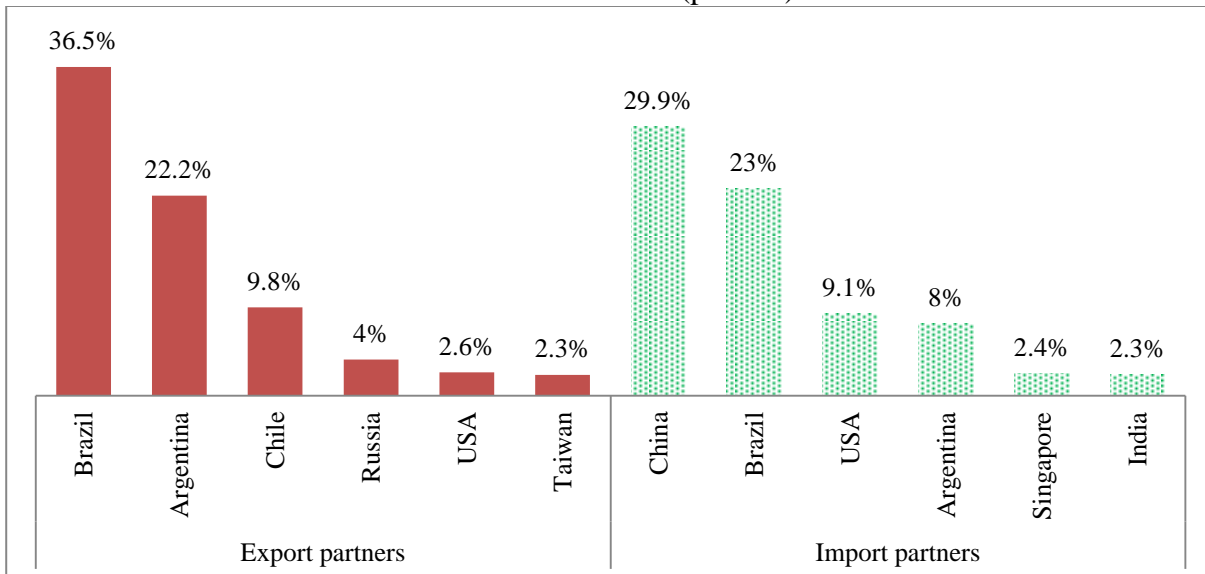

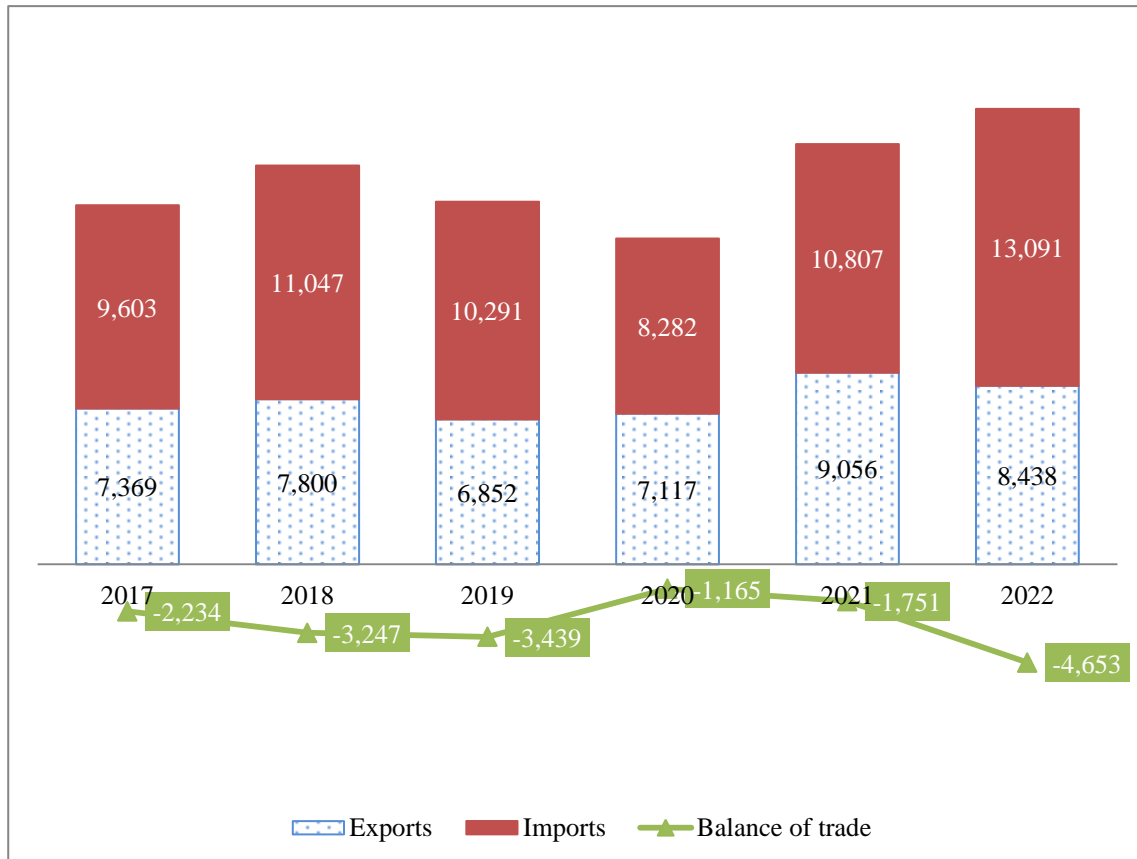

Summary of the Paraguayan International Trade

Exports (FOB)

- January-October 2021: USD 9,056 million
- January-October 2022: USD 8,438 million
- Growth in value: USD -618 million
- Growth in percentage: -6.8%

Countries or trade blocs that mostly impacted on exports growth

- Russia (USD -368 million)
- MERCOSUR (USD -333 million)
- ASEAN (USD 108 million)

Products that mostly impacted on exports outcome

- Soybeans (USD -1,579 million)
- Electricity (USD -67 million)
- Maize (USD 434 million)

Imports (CIF)

- January-October 2021: USD 10,807 million
- January-October 2022: USD 13,091 million
- Growth in value: USD 2,285 million

- MERCOSUR (USD 466 million)

Products that mostly impacted on imports outcome

- Petroleum (USD 709 million)
